strong commitment to working towards stopping child abuse and reducing school dropouts, and a collaborative action plan was established to guide their efforts.

Awareness program on Appropriate and Inappropriate touch:

On 21st of April, DSWS organized a awareness program on Appropriate and Inappropriate touch at Bamumjuli Tea Garden. The objective of the awareness program was to educate children and youth about the differences between appropriate and inappropriate touch, empowering them to recognize, resist, and report any form of abuse.
